





3. 'Teacher vs Student Badminton Competition' was held on 8th July, 1987. This was



Secondly, in order to arouse their interest in bridge and chess games, we lent some cards and various kinds of chess for them to play every Tuesday after school.





We welcome all the students in the school to join the S.C.F..Preaching the good news to our schoolmates and promoting spiritual growth among Christians are its main aims.


