Our greatest annual event, Grand Show, was held in April. We had a variety of performances and the hall was full of laughter and applause.


In Activity Week, we had a friendly match with Wa Ying Secondary School basket-ball team, a fun fair, a table tennis match and a badminton match between the staff and students.

Art Society



Secondly, in order to arouse their interest in bridge and chess games, we lent some cards and various kinds of chess for them to play every Tuesday after school.






School Choir

We welcome all the students in the school to join the S.C.F.. Preaching the good news to our schoolmates and promoting spiritual growth among Christians are its main aims.




Tennis Club





In 1986-87, Wing Sheh has about 160 members, all of which are our F. 2 fellow-students.


Activities Participated : —

Our society presented a drama called "Enlightenment" (悟) which won very encouraging comments.



Kin Sheh




